Air Conditioning: Just a reminder that the air conditioning is running in the church and the narthex. If you see the doors opened to the outside of the church, please close them and help save money.

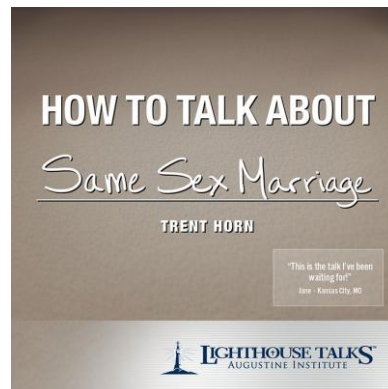


Summer VBS!!- July 10-14
