When things go wrong in life, it's human nature to fall back and regroup. We instinctively look for a safe quiet place to think things out. But oftentimes in our desire to hide, we lock out the positive as well. Some doors, once closed, can prove difficult to pry open, leaving us isolated from people who love us. We stand inside our little safe room avoiding pain, and end up avoiding joy as well. Following that fearful Passover week, the disciples too were hungry for a quiet, secure place. They huddled behind closed doors, physical and emotional; trying to sort out what went wrong. But the joyous message of today's Gospel is that even locked in, safe behind closed doors, God's truth will find you out. Jesus will arrive in your secret hiding place to declare his presence and healing power. When you are unable to go out and face the world, He will come in to you. How blessed it is, that even in the upper rooms of our lives He gives us nowhere to hide from His love.

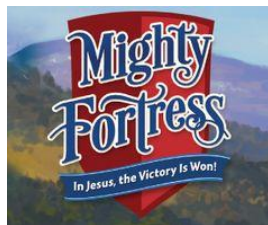
